**Story Time**—Mondays at 1 PM

(Ages 3-6) Preschoolers are invited to join Miss Love for a half-hour of songs, stories, and felt-board activities. Each session will be followed by the Alphabet Book program. Adult caregiver participation is required.

**ABC Book Crafting**—Mondays at 1:30 PM

(Ages 3-6) Help your child learn to read by creating his/her own Alphabet Book. Beginning with the letter "A", each session will focus on one new letter of the alphabet until your child has crafted all 26 letters. This program follows each Monday's story time session.
